REGISTRATION DEADLINES

New Yorkers must register to vote by certain deadlines to be eligible to vote in Primary and General Elections. There are also deadlines for making changes to your registration, such as changes to address or enrollment.

VOTING DEADLINES

There are several <u>ways to vote</u> in New York State, including in-person and early voting. Those voting by absentee ballot or military and overseas voting must adhere to specific deadlines per election.



Register Online

- Use the NYS Board of Elections Online Voter Registration system to register to vote or to make changes to your voter registration information.
- To register online at NYS BOE website, you will need to use a NY.Gov ID. If you have previously used NY.Gov with another agency, you may use the same login to access the Online Voter Registration portal. If you have not used NY.Gov, you will need to create an account. Once you have a NY.Gov account, you may register to vote online.
 To start, login in with your NY.gov ID or Create a Personal Account. Once you have your NY.gov ID, you can then login into the NYS BOE Voter Registration Portal.





Register In-Person

• Register in-person at your county board of elections, any New York State Agency-Based voter registration center, or the Department of Motor Vehicles.

Register by Mail

• Enter your name into the Board of Elections' mailer list or call 1-800-FOR-VOTE to request an application, then mail the completed form to your county board of elections.

Early Voting

Early voting is 9 days of voting for eligible voters at ANY of the designated poll sites in your county. All NYC voters must vote at their ASSIGNED poll locations.
