In advance of voting November 5th, **make sure your registration status is active**. Go online and check your registration status. Websites you can use, include **vote411.org** or **https://voterlookup.elections.ny.gov/**. If you check your status and you're an active voter, you are good to go. Getting registered is only the first step. It's equally important to stay

registered and to make sure you protect your right to vote. Encourage your friends to spread the word about being certain their voter registration is active. People move, something changes, who knows, just double check BEFORE election day to be certain your registration is active. Spread the word on this **please!**

Even Year Elections Law Deemed Unconstitutional

On Tuesday, a New York state Supreme Court judge ruled that the new state law that would move many local elections to line up with state and federal elections in even-numbered years violates the state Constitution.

The League does not have a position that would allow us to support or oppose this bill, but it would have huge impact on how our elections would run so we are keeping tabs on this issue. The court case will NOT impact the November 2024 election.

Celebrate Golden Day!

In December of 2023 Governor Kathy Hochul signed legislation that reduced the time required for voter registration forms to be submitted in person from at twenty-five days prior to an election, to only 10 days before an election. This means that voters can register to vote and vote on the SAME day- October 26th!

Where in the news is the State League?

This week we were quoted in a Times Union article on the lack of proper implementation of poll sites on college campuses. We partnered with NYPIRG and several other voting rights

organizations to call out this issue ahead of the election.

"While recent legislation aimed to facilitate voting for New York's 1.1 million college-age students, we have yet to see significant increases in on-campus polling locations," said Erica Smitka, Executive Director of the New York League of Women Voters, which cosigned the letter. "By ensuring that these sites are conveniently located, we can empower students to actively engage in the democratic process and make their voices heard on the issues that matter most to them."
