**Exciting News**: Vote411 has a new feature that allows voters to see who funds a candidate's campaign. This new tool gives voters additional information about the candidate prior to casting their ballot. Please spread the word on this new feature, maybe with a press release!

LWVUS mailed Get Out the Vote (GOTV) materials to every local League to the address LWVUS had on file in the Roster Manager Portal or to the current president. Link up with your local League to help distribute these materials in the last days before the general election to GOTV!

Finally, the Annual League Survey from **LWVUS**, will be sent to your League's highest-ranking officer on January 2, 2025. Make sure your League updates officer roles in the Roster Manager Portal by November 1. The **LWVUS** Annual League Survey *is different from* the Voter Service Survey from LWVNY.

We have just over 20 days until the general election. Passage of Proposition 1 depends on our efforts, whether with phone banking, speaking at meetings, or distribution of materials. It has been a long journey. Let's cross that finish line and bring passage of Prop 1 home!

## DO VERIFY BEFORE YOU SHARE

Consider the source, check the date, and cross-check the information across outlets.



## DO QUESTION THE CONTENT

Read past the headline and question emotionally charged content.



### DO SHARE ACCURATE INFORMATION

Without mentioning the wrong info, set the record straight by sharing the correct messages.



### **DO REPORT IT**

Report inaccurate info to social media platforms, group administrators, and election officials.

### **DON'T CLICK OR SHARE**

If you quote the bad information, you help spread it.



## **DON'T ENGAGE PUBLICLY**

If someone you know is sharing bad info, message them privately and ask them to take it down.

#### **Important Dates**

- October 26th: Last day to register to vote and to apply for an absentee ballot or early vote by mail ballot online/via mail.
- October 26th November 3rd: Vote early from Saturday the 26th to Sunday the 3rd. Check out your county board of elections website to find the closest early voting poll site to you. \*If you're in NYC you will be assigned an early voting poll site\*
- **November 5th:** Election Day! This is also the last day to postmark your absentee ballots or early vote by mail ballot.

When you are seeking voting information, VOTE411.org is the perfect tool to use. This is a **national** voter guide. Everyone can check their voter registration status from here; register to vote; and obtain ballot and candidates' information. Feel free to share this website information with your family and friends who reside anywhere in the U.S.
